## EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

A recording fee of 50 cents will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. Also, as of January 1, 2005, AKC will collect a \$1.50 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of each dog. These fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to The American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class at the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2). A recording fee of \$3.00 will be collected for each Rally entry (Rally Regulations Chapter 1, Section 3)

Move ups will be allowed in accordance with the Obedience Regulations Chapter 1, Section 16.

Only exhibitor's dogs are permitted on the grounds. We request that any dog causing a disturbance be removed from the Ring area. All dogs must be on leash except when being judged.

Entries should be typed or printed, except for the proper signature, on Official American Kennel Club entry form only.

Special Awards: When there is a double entry of the same dog, only the highest score will be eligible for Special Awards. Be sure to include all of the dog's AKC titles on the entry form. Only AKC titles will be printed in the catalog.

If because of weather, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of MDTC it is impossible to open or to complete this show, no refund of entry fee will be made. In the event of extreme weather, this show may be cancelled.

A refund of \$10.00 for an entered bitch that comes in season after entries close will be made upon presentation of a statement by a licensed veterinarian to the Trial Secretary by 8:00 A.M. the day of the show.

Exhibitors from outside Wisconsin must comply with the following regulations. Wisconsin Dept. of Agriculture Effective date: June 11, 1996 Last update: Feb. 9, 2001

No permits are required for any dog or domestic cat entering Wisconsin.

Dogs and domestic cats must be accompanied by a certificate of veterinary inspection that shows the status of the last rabies vaccination, including the date of rabies vaccination and the date the animal is due for re-vaccination. Rabies vaccine must be administered by a licensed veterinarian. Vaccination shall comply with age, time standards, and label instructions for the type of vaccine used.

I (we) waive any and all claims, causes of action, I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC approved judge, judging at this show, under the "AKC Rules, Regulations and Guidelines". I (we) agree that the club holding this show, obedience trial and/or agility trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard), Collies (rough, smooth).
- The following categories or dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. 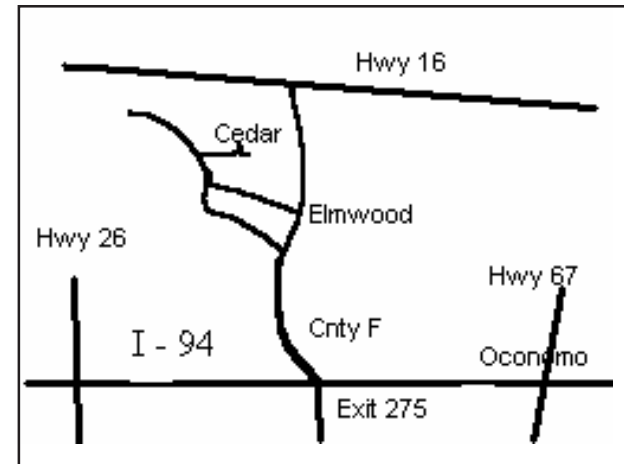
